An International event

Now in its fourth edition, the Adriatic Sea Forum is an itinerant event conceived by Risposte Turismo - research and consulting company, operating within the tourism macro-industry, founded and led by Francesco di Cesare – and dedicated to maritime tourism in the Adriatic Sea.

Adriatic Sea Forum, thanks to its widely appreciated formula, is a crucial meeting point for all players with interests in the cruise, ferry and nautical areas (sail & yacht) in the Adriatic.

Since 2013, the forum has made an important contribution to sharing ideas and facilitating the development of new projects, as well as launching joint strategies and collaborations among the professionals.

Countries involved

During the Adriatic Sea Forum, topics of interest to 7 nations (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Greece, Montenegro, Italy and Slovenia), 25 regions and more than 150 destinations on the both sides of the Adriatic will be discussed.







The event is an occasion for **meetings**, **discussions and in-depth analysis** among all the operators and those interested in the various sectors (shipping companies, cruise and ferry terminals, marinas and ports, maritime agencies, tour operators, travel agencies, charter companies, shipyards, public administration, local tourism boards) and for all those who want to get a better insight into the characteristics and the dynamics involved.

The format

The Adriatic Sea Forum consists of **meetings**, **debates and business network opportunities** during which all participants will have the opportunity to improve their knowledge, to create new relationships and strengthen the existing ones, and to promote their own activities and projects.

The previous editions

Adriatic Sea Forum returns this year with the 2019 edition following the first three events held in Trieste (2013), Dubrovnik (2015) and in Budva (2017).

The previous editions were a great success: in addition to the large number of participants and speakers, the content that emerged from the

various debates proved especially stimulating for those taking part. Over 200 operators - including entrepreneurs, managers, figures from the public administration, researchers and representatives of the European projects - took part in each edition, making an active contribution to the discussions and debates, as well as developing new business relationships.













ADRIATIC SEA FORUM - CRUISE, FERRY, SAIL & YACHT The 2019 edition: May 30th and 31st, Ancona

Date and location

The 2019 edition of the Adriatic Sea Forum is organised in partnership with the Central Adriatic Ports Authority and it will take place Thursday the 30th and Friday the 31st of May at Mole Vanvitelliana, a building designed by Luigi Vanvitelli and built in 1773 on an artificial island with the port of Ancona.

A specific section of the Mole Vanvitelliana is dedicated to conference activities and hosts meetings of national and international importance during the year, in addition to those more related to the topicalities of the territory.





The programme

The confirmed structure of the event consists of plenary discussion sessions and thematic insights on specific areas of interest that alternate with presentations, interviews and face to face, this year completed by three technical tables discussing the priorities to be assigned that would facilitate the growth of each of the Forum's three sectors.

Among the topics that will be discussed at the round tables are the sharing of choices and actions that could accelerate the growth of the Adriatic sea through maritime tourism, the intervention and investment priorities that the area port authorities



identify, with reference to the different aspects of passenger traffic, the possibility of pursuing economic growth and environmental protection, the important setbacks for the territories generated by the giga yacht tourism, the competitiveness of ferries in a changed framework of mobility and transport offer, the novelties that could characterize Adriatic the cruise industry in the near future.



The event, which will take place in three languages (Italian, English and Croatian), will also allow all participants – through dedicated speeches by other prestigious speakers - to keep up to date with the European programs dedicated to the area and with the EUSAIR strategy five years after its launch, to learn more about the characteristics, demands and expectations of customers interested in the Adriatic tourist offer, and to learn about actualities outside the Adriatic area that have excelled in maritime tourism.

Adriatic Sea Forum 2019 will once again host Alumni@ASF, a project that allows 50 students or recent graduates under 30 from universities and master's courses in the countries that face onto both sides of the Adriatic to take part in the event, follow the proceedings and make contact with the operators present (to apply: http://www.adriaticseaforum.com/alumniasf-2019-applications/).

In the opening section of the Forum, the new edition of the Adriatic Sea Tourism Report will be presented - the research conducted by Risposte Turismo since 2013 which analyses the flows, dimensions, nature and directions of tourist sea

This Italian forum is the first ever event dedicated to the phenomenon of the shopping tourism in Italy.

The profile of the president Francesco di Cesare

The president of the company is Francesco di Cesare. He combines his commitments to teaching, research and consultancy on the main topics of the macro-industry of travel and tourism and cultural production, publishing as author or co-author numerous articles and reviews, with operative interventions also in the organisation of big events.



Besides texts and contributions about tourism marketing in general, congress tourism, cultural production and relations between cinema tourism and territories, there are numerous articles and papers dedicated to maritime and cruise tourism, of which he is author, coauthor or editor.
